People awarded the National Certificate Level 1 in Adult Literacy are able to:

- ▶ read and write simple sentences to form paragraphs.
- ▶ apply numbers in daily life situations.
- ▶ to perform simple operations using ICT.
- ▶ communicate effectively.

- ▶ Read and write sentences.
- ▶ Use data in real life context.
- ▶ Solve mathematical problems in real life situations.
- ▶ Develop ICT skills.
- ▶ Search, develop and print information using information and communication technology.
